### How We Help

**Rent/mortgage, utilities, fuel, food, and prescription medication (and air conditioning when medically necessary)**



Clients are interviewed to determine the extent of need, available resources, involvement of other agencies, and a realistic plan to move the client back toward financial independence.

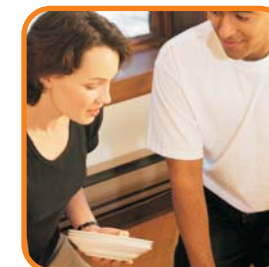

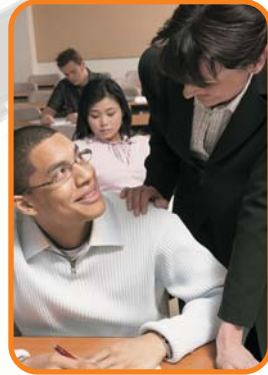

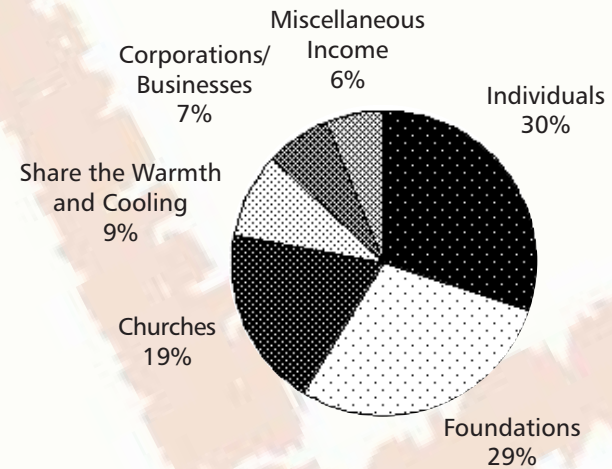

## History

Crisis Control Ministry (CCM) was founded in April 1973 by a group of area churches to establish a compassionate, comprehensive system of response to the emergency needs of people in serious financial crisis. For over thirty years, CCM, has provided direct services to the economically poor, working poor, elderly, disabled, and others who find themselves in survival crises with the help of over 600 dedicated volunteers who do the work of the ministry. Our contributions to the community include helping thousands of people annually to endure financial crisis, opening North Carolina's first free pharmacy (located at our Winston-Salem office), initiating what is now Samaritan Ministries, starting the Bethesda Center for the Homeless, collaborating with other organizations, and serving our clients with compassion, integrity, and grace. We are proud of our history and grateful for the perpetual community support.



## Funding and Resources



The Ministry is funded primarily through individual donors, followed by local community foundations, and local churches. Other sources of income include the annual Share the Warmth Heating and Cooling campaign, the Feinstein Challenge, and support from generous corporations and local businesses. Crisis Control Ministry is not a United Way agency, nor does it receive government funding.



## Volunteering

At Crisis Control Ministry, the volunteers are an integral part of providing help to those in crisis situations. By volunteering for three hours per week, one person can help change the life of a family within Forsyth County. Monthly, there are more than 600 volunteers who give of their time and energy to make a difference within the community. There are no specific skill level requirements, and training is provided for all positions. Volunteer opportunities range from helping out in the pharmacy, Client Choice Food Pantry, interviewing clients, administrative and computer work. In addition to helping families within Forsyth county, being involved with CCM makes volunteers feel a connection with their surrounding community, gain friendships, and have the opportunity to be a part of a team that is working together for those in crisis. Volunteering at CCM for three hours a week gets families back on track, and truly makes a difference.
