Too often Christians fail to see the day-to-day relevance of the Bible, confining their Christianity to Sunday mornings. Since we believe the future of the modern American church largely depends on well-prepared people who take seriously biblical claims of truth, we strive to move Christians from the sideline to the game.

For interested skeptics, we analyze barriers to faith while seeking opportunities to share the Gospel—always emphasizing the need for a “fixed point” of reference in one’s life. Unlike strictly evangelical ministries, Fixed Point Foundation does accept opportunities to discuss non-biblical topics and concerns in settings traditionally considered hostile to the Christian message.


While we recognize that only God can change a life, we also believe—from direct experience—that many otherwise immovable hearts can be reached through the head. Which is why, in short, we need to talk.
