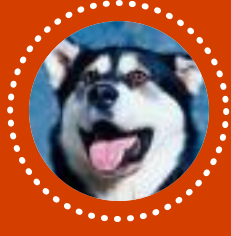
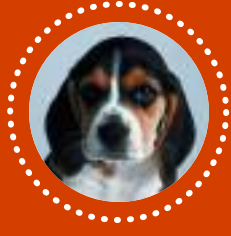

The Animal Placement Bureau (APB) provides rescue, rehabilitation, medical care and placement services for more than 300 dogs every year. ### What Is Fostering All About?
